



Career Corps Youth Programs

For **16-24 year old Chester County residents**. Services include 1-on-1 career advising and exploration, job search assistance, career preparedness workshops, paid work experience and internships, and funding and referrals for work-related supportive services. *Dual enrollment in adult programs may allow for grant-funded training opportunities.*

ELIGIBILITY: Falls into the categories of **In-School Youth** or **Out-of-School Youth**.

In-School Youth are defined as an individual who is in school as defined by state law, is a low-income individual, AND has one or more barriers, as mentioned above. *(Slots limited based on funding)*

Out-of-School Youth are defined as an individual who does not attend school, has one or more of the following:

- High school dropout
- Within the age of attendance required and has not attended school for at least a quarter.
- Received a secondary school diploma or GED, is low-income individual, **and** has an additional barrier.

Barrier examples include:

- Basic skills deficient or an English language learner
 - Subject to the juvenile or adult justice system
 - Homeless or in foster care
 - Pregnant or parenting
 - Has a disability
 - Requires Additional assistance to complete an educational program or to secure or hold employment
- *NOTE: Individuals with disability as a barrier are exempt from income requirements.*
